- Organ concert tours in all European countries, U.S.A. (39 tours), Bahamas, Israel, Iceland, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, Hong Kong, Singapore, Bangkok
- Radio and TV broadcasts, 18 CD recordings (Motette, Wergo, IFO, Organophon labels)
- Author of the books "Alexandre Guilmant - Life and Work" and "Famous Organs in the U.S.A."
- Honored by the French government in Paris for his worldwide engagement in French organ music and nominated "Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres" in 1985
