

WORSHIP

We celebrate God by experiencing music that is excellent and grounded in tradition, liturgy that is historical and relevant, and inviting all to participate in weekly Eucharist.

Numerous people serve in a variety of ways to craft meaningful worship services that honor God and uplift people. Some of our worship related ministries include...

- Altar Guild – a team who prepares our altar for worship and Eucharist
- Choirs – We have Choir practice on Wednesday 7:00-8:30p.m. (Spanish) and Thursdays (English) from 7:30-9p.m. and the Choir sings at the 10:00, 11:45 and 1:00p.m. services and special events
- Healing Prayer Ministry – Volunteers stand in the Chapel during Eucharist to pray with anyone who wishes
- Lay Eucharistic Ministers – Individuals who are trained and licensed by the Bishop to administer the Chalice during Eucharist and to take communion to folks at home or in the hospital
- Lectors – Volunteers who read from the Scriptures on Sundays
- Music & Instruments – We are always looking for ways to incorporate musicians into our Worship Services
- Ushers – Volunteers who greet folks, distribute bulletins, take offering, bring forth the bread and Wine and guide people to seating



EDUCATION

All Saints offers a variety of opportunities for growth. We value formation in everyone from babies to senior saints. We offer informative and inspiring classes, fun cultural events, and interesting trips and times to fellowship in the Las Vegas Valley. Here are a few of the Education related ministries at All Saints...



- Adult Electives – A variety of informative and inspiring classes are offered at different times
- Adventurers – Fun and interesting excursions together to places like museums, Vegas sights, Art Collections and many more places that all end with fellowship and a great lunch
- Confirmation – A post-baptismal rite of mature commitment to Christ signified by the laying on of hands by the Bishop following classes
- Communion Instruction for Kids – A time when baptized children celebrate taking communion for the first time preceded by a class of preparation
- Men & Women of Purpose – An evening of Bible Study, fellowship and food (In Spanish)
- Sunday School – Fun age appropriate classes to learn about the Christian Life
- Youth Group – A fun, inspiring and loving community of teens who grow in their Christian Life together who meet on Sunday mornings, Tuesday nights and for special events
- Young Adults – A fellowship group for post-high schoolers to 30 somethings



FELLOWSHIP

All Saints is a community of real though imperfect people who love an inclusive God who shares radical grace with us. It is our job to share God's grace through hospitality and care for everyone. We show our care for folks through some of the following ministries...

- Coffee Hour – A time of fellowship that includes coffee and pastries – Most Sundays include Latin American food for sale in the courtyard as well
- Hospitality Team – This team of volunteers plans and prepares special events and the Coffee Hour each week
- Memorial Hospitality – All Saints host memorials for our members and folks from the community and we like to show we care
- Needlers – A team of volunteers who craft beautiful blankets and shawls for those in need
- Pastry with the Priest – This is an informal time monthly to get to know our Rector and more about All Saints
- Pastoral Care Team – This group of trained volunteers pray for and visit those who are sick in our community
- Prayer Chain – A prayer list that is emailed to our folks
- Weddings – All Saints hosts wedding for our members and community



OUTREACH

God has called us to touch the lives of those in our immediate community, valley, state, country and world. We do this through a variety of ways including...

- Community Computer Room – We maintain a room of computers and wi-fi for people to use computers for communication, job search, etc.
- Food Bank – All Saints send 3 volunteers every Friday to serve as well
- Gibson Middle School – We regularly help the staff and students of the school just across the street from us
- Internet Outreach – We try to stay active on the internet and social media through regular posts and live streaming our services
- Missionaries to Chile, Russ & Hiedi Smith – We support our missionaries through regular giving, prayer, hosting them and trips
- Recovery Groups – We are happy to host a Narcotics Anonymous group for women every Tuesday night at 6:00pm and Gamblers Anonymous every Friday night at 7:00pm
- Street Teens – Is an organization in our valley that provides education, food, clothing and many other resources to homeless teenagers
